



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q. Is there a fee for the students?

A. Girl Power® is completely free for students. All expenses are covered by the host, sponsors and partners.

Q. For what age group is Girl Power® intended?

A. Girl Power® is designed primarily for high school students in grades 9–12. Older girls interested in exploring careers in the trades are also welcome to participate.

Q. Who is the intended audience for Girl Power®?

A. The program is geared toward high school girls enrolled in technical or STEM programs, as well as those still exploring future career options and curious about opportunities in the utility trades.

Q. What should the students wear for this event?

A. To participate in all activities, students must wear the required attire: long-sleeved shirts, long pants and closed-toe shoes (outdoor boots preferred). Safety equipment will be provided.

Q. Is lunch included?

A. Yes, lunch and snacks are provided. If a student has any allergies, please be sure to bring lunch and snacks.

Q. Are parents or chaperones allowed to stay and observe Girl Power®?

A. Yes. Parents and chaperones may stay and observe the event. They must register online as a “Spectator” in order to receive a lunch.

Q. Is a permission slip/waiver needed to attend?

A. Yes, this is a hands-on experience. All students **must** have a signed permission slip to participate in any climbing, bucket truck and/or tool events. Minors must have a guardian sign their permission slip prior to the event.

Q. What happens if there is inclement weather?

A. This is a rain or shine event. Come prepared for any kind of weather (raincoat, etc.).
